Data is automatically delivered to Project Accounting for allocation to specific clients, and then to Accounts Receivable for invoicing. Information is also posted to the Abra HR and Abra Payroll modules, eliminating redundancies in data entry.

“We’re really pleased with the way that MAS 500 provides us with an end-to-end system,” says Teresa Bartlett, internal developer with CRI Advantage. “It’s now much easier to track expenses and stay up-to-date on project status. Before, we had stand-alone applications that broke out data in different ways, so it was hard to create reports. MAS 500 lets us consolidate information for real-time analysis, and then view that information however we like.”

Better Expense Tracking and Reporting

In addition to logging time spent on particular jobs, CRI employees use the eTimesheets module to record billable expenses. “Our people in the field can now go on the Internet to enter out-of-pocket claims into eTimesheets to make claims for travel costs and meals,” says Bartlett. “This is very convenient for us, because we always know exactly how much is being charged against each customer’s account, and employees can be reimbursed directly

through our AP module.”

The system also tracks recurring expenses including high-speed data lines for staff members who work from home. Since all project-related data is now stored in one place, it is easier to monitor project profitability.

CRI Advantage’s reseller was instrumental in achieving a smooth conversion to the new system and providing customization to meet the company’s needs. They developed a full suite of financial reports, migrated data from a former project management module, and created a new invoice format to convey the company’s image of professionalism.
